The Faculty of Humanities is proud to announce the appointment of Prof Jane Taylor and Prof David Bunn.

Prof Bunn was a senior Professor and chair of History of Art in the Division of Visual Arts up until 2008. Prof Jane Taylor is a renowned playwright and academic, and was the Skye Chair of Drama at the University of the Witwatersrand.

Prof Taylor is considering Master's and Doctoral applications in the following fields: The history of the modern subject, theories of rupture, conversion and the invention of the self; the history of performance from the sixteenth century to the present; theories of the object; circulation and the object; film studies, Kentridge and/or Handspring Puppet Company; and on museums, collectors, curators.

Prof Bunn is considering applications in the following fields: Literary and cultural theory, contemporary visual art, visual culture, modernism, contemporary South African cultural studies, environmental and conservation studies.

Any Master's or Doctorate student who registers at the University of Johannesburg (UJ) for the first time in 2010, and who completes his/her degree in the specified time (two year for a Master's and three years for a Doctorate), may apply to be reimbursed for the full tuition fees paid for the specified term. Students will need to submit their graduation certificate in order to qualify for the reimbursement.

This offer excludes all other cost, i.e. registration fees, ICT levy, residence costs, etc. and is not valid if you receive third party sponsorship towards your tuition fees.
