
1. **Go to the website:** <https://elearning.treee.org/>.

Objectives: At the end of Module 1, participants will:

- be able to identify values and concepts of ethics relevant to the conduct of research involving humans,
- be able to identify and consult relevant normative documents,
- be able to understand the importance of ethical evaluation in the promotion of the highest ethical standards,
- understand the role and mandate of research ethics committees.

Overview: Module 1 has 4 parts including 14 questions in all.

You must get the correct answer before moving ahead. At the end of this module, a certificate is available for participants who achieve a score of 70% or higher. A certificate is available on this page. If the rate of 70% correct answers is not reached, the user can restart the Module.

The use of the words “correct” and “incorrect” to qualify the chosen answer indicates, for some questions, which are intended as a means of prompting and furthering reflection.
