STUDENTS CURRENTLY ENROLLED ON THE TWO YEAR CONTINUING EDUCATION PROGRAMME

We have previously advised students that as from 2015 there will be a restructuring of our Continuing Education Programmes as well as changes to the admission requirements to these programmes.

The following programme will be affected:

Diploma in Logistics Management (DLB002)

As a result of the above changes all students currently enrolled on the above diploma will become "pipeline" students as from 2015 and will complete their studies subject to the admission requirements and NQF levels which have been in force up to 2014. Students will be granted a period of four calendar years (i.e. the end of 2018) to complete their current studies. Students who have not completed their studies by 2018 and wish to continue, will lose credits for any modules passed and will be required to enrol for the new qualification, subject to the rules and regulations that are stipulated in the prospectus as from 2015.

Go to *Administrative Utilities* and click on *ITS iEnabler*.

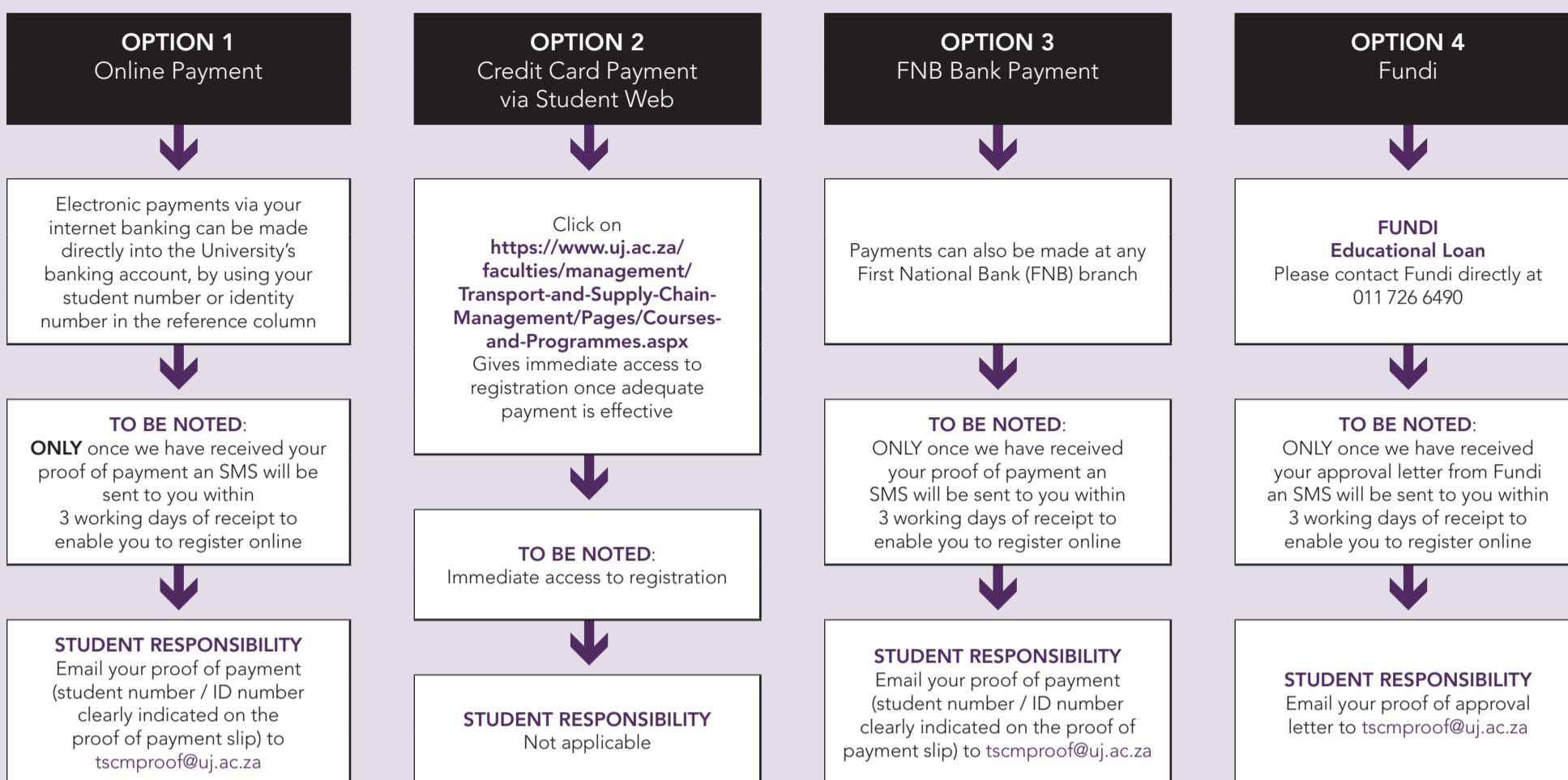
Check your addresses and contact details. Make sure your study address is loaded (physical address where you are during the day to receive study material via courier services).
