STUDENTS CURRENTLY ENROLLED ON THE CONTINUING EDUCATION PROGRAMMES

We have previously advised students in 2014 that there will be a restructuring of our Continuing Education Programmes as well as changes to the admission requirements to these programmes.

Students were granted a period of four calendar years to complete the Transportation Management Diploma.

As a result of the above changes all students currently enrolled on the programme are "pipeline" students and will complete their studies subject to the admission requirements and NQF levels which have been in force up to 2014.

Students have the remaining period of two calendar years (i.e. the end of 2018) to complete their current studies. **Students who have not completed their studies by 2018 and wish to continue, will lose credits for any modules passed and will be required to enrol for the new qualification, subject to the rules and regulations that are stipulated in the prospectus.**

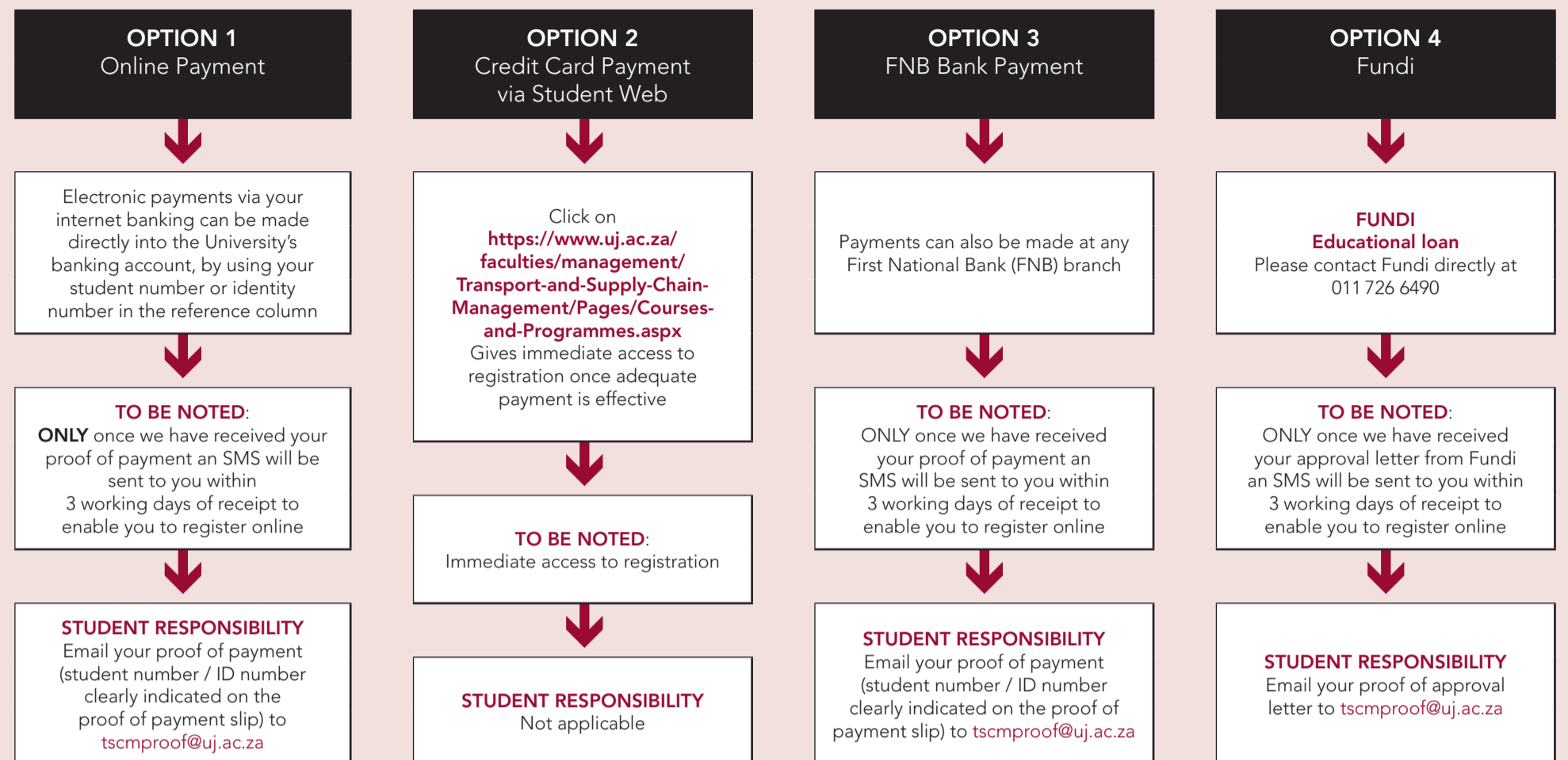
ONLINE REGISTRATION DATE: 10 JANUARY – 28 FEBRUARY
