#### FOR WHOM?

The Faculty of Science provides registered and provisionally registered UJ students with a 2nd chance to improve their matric results to enable them to qualify for the science degree or diploma programs. The students redo certain subjects and are issued with a new UMALUSI certificate upon successful completion of the year. Only 60 (sixty) candidates are accommodated in this program per year.

#### WHERE?

TechnoLab, Auckland Park Kingsway Campus, University of Johannesburg.  
(corner Kingsway and University Road, Auckland Park)

#### WHEN?

February – November 2017 (Mondays – Thursdays, 2 hours per subject, twice a week = 4 hours per week).

#### SUBJECTS?

Mathematics. Physical Sciences. Life Sciences.

#### SUPPORT?

Learners will be provided with the following:

- all study material (notes and textbooks) per subject;
- 2 x 2 hour lectures per subject per week;
- tests and exams required to complete the SBA per subject;
- memorandums for the tests;
- quarterly reports;
- access to practical laboratories – in TechnoLab;
- registration for the 2017 final matric exam;
- UMALUSI accredited marks certificate upon successful completion of course;
- UJ student card.

#### FEES?

One subject only:

R 1 250.00 (Registration fee) + (1 x R 7 500.00) = R 8 750.00

Two subjects:

R 1 250.00 (Registration fee) + (2 x R 7 500.00) = R 16 250.00

Three subjects:

R 1 250.00 (Registration fee) + (3 x R 7 500.00) = R 23 750.00

**PLEASE NOTE: NO candidate will be allowed to continue with the course if all fees are not paid up by 31 May 2017. These candidates will be deregistered by SACAI and will forfeit any fees already paid.**

#### APPLICATION?

To apply a candidate must:

- have a UJ student number or a provisional UJ student number;
- have written matric between 2014 – 2016;
- provide a Matric Certificate or Statement of Results;
- have passed all subjects:
  - English with a minimum mark of 60 % (5)
  - 2nd Language with a minimum mark of 50 % (4)
  - Other subjects, not being repeated at UJ, with a minimum mark of 50 % (4)
  - Maths core or above 70% for maths literacy in Matric.

Only students intending to complete their further tertiary qualification at the University of Johannesburg in the following faculties will be accepted onto this program:

- Faculty of Science;
- Faculty of Engineering and the Built Environment;
- Faculty of Health Sciences.

#### Learners who completed matric in 2014 – 2015:

Application forms will be made available from 25th of October 2016 you will need your UMALUSI Certificate to apply, a Statement of Results will NOT be accepted.

#### Learners who are currently in matric (2016):

No application forms will be available before Tuesday the 4th of January 2017. Statement of Results will be needed to apply in 2017.

**Applications will close on Monday the 10th of January 2017** when selection of candidates will be done.

Successful candidates will be informed on Friday the 14th of January 2017.
