Crawshay-Hall, Jayne Kelly (PhD)

Jayne Crawshay-Hall is a curator, art historian and artist who is the Academic Head at the Open Window Institute in Centurion. She studied at the University of Pretoria, completing her Bachelor of Fine Art degree (with distinction) in 2010 and her Master of Fine Art degree (with distinction) in 2013. In 2015, she helped to establish NO END Contemporary Art Space, an artist-run contemporary art platform in Johannesburg, which she now co-owns. She has curated numerous exhibitions, authored scholarly articles and undertaken artist residences in Paris (2012) and Berlin (2015).

Recent years have seen the primary role of the art curator shifting from the care of art objects to the generation of ideas and discourse. In her meticulously researched thesis, Jayne Crawshay-Hall explores how this shift informed curating in Johannesburg between 2007 and 2016. Focusing on curators operating outside the formal employ of museums, she shows how their independence enabled a range of groundbreaking art exhibitions. She also reveals that, rather than simply importing curatorial strategies, independent local curators drew many of their understandings from influential mega-exhibitions held in South Africa during the late 1980s and 1990s. Her examiners all commended the study for its originality. As one observed, “it offers a much needed, indeed pioneering discussion of the contemporary field of curatorship and in particular of the rise of independent curators” as well as offering “a methodology for future studies in other parts of the country”.
