Kinfack Djoumessi, Emilie Chanceline (PhD)

Ms Emilie Kinfack holds a Bachelors in Economics from the University of Dschang (Cameroon), as well as an Honours and a Master's degree in Economics from UNISA. She has conducted research for many non-governmental organisations in Africa.

Ms Kinfack focused her research on the financial sector, international trade and small and medium enterprises. Her study seeks answers to four research questions at the heart of deepening knowledge of the complex channels through which economic integration affects the development of the African continent.

Emilie Kinfack managed to apply several advanced econometric models and obtained results that will inform economic policies aiming at fostering economic integration throughout the African continent. Several chapters of her thesis are currently under review in international journals.

Kolade, Sunday Adesina (PhD)

Mr Sunday Adesina Kolade holds BSc in Banking and Finance from the University of Ado-Ekiti and a MSc in Finance from the University of Lagos. His research interest centres on the African banking sector, notably interpreting the determinants and effects of bank intellectual capital, capital adequacy, risk-taking behaviour, efficiency, profitability, competition and market discipline.

Mr Adesina Kolade focuses examined the relevance of the Basel III countercyclical capital buffer requirement. Also, the possible effects of the Basel III higher common equity capital requirements on banking lending rates, bank risk-taking behaviour, and bank efficiency in Africa. To this purpose a panel dataset of 257 commercial banks in 23 African countries over the 2004–2014 period was used. The thesis contributed, firstly, that the sampled 23 African banking systems are not exposed to contagion and systemic risks arising from countercyclical movements of bank capital buffers to the real economy. Second, that the implementation of the Basel III higher equity capital requirements is likely to have lesser effects on lending rates in South Africa and Nigeria compared to Egypt and Kenya. Thirdly, that the risk appetite of banks increases as their market power increases. Also, that countries with a higher inflation rate are less conducive to efficient banking operations. Finally, that the efficiency reducing effect of inflation decreases as GDP per capital increases.

The thesis makes substantial contributions to the banking literature and impact directly on investors, bank managements, and bank regulators who are concerned with bank performance, safety, and soundness.

Tang, Vanessa Tan Knuck Chow (PhD)

Miss Vanessa Tang obtained her bachelors and Honours degrees in Economics at the University of Port Elizabeth, and her Master's degree in Economic Policy with several distinctions at the University of Stellenbosch. Prior to joining academia, she worked at Banque Indosuez as an Information Technology trade analyst. Since 2004, she has been employed as a lecturer in the School of Accounting, Economics and Finance at the University of KwaZulu-Natal, where she teaches international economics at undergraduate and postgraduate levels. She has co-authored or compiled several publications, including books, journals and refereed conference proceedings.

Miss Tang's thesis examines the role of trade in the development of Mauritius. Her thesis comprises four empirical essays linked to this common theme. In the first essay, time series econometric analysis finds a positive and robust relationship between trade and economic growth. For the second essay, the candidate collected primary firm level data for firms operating in Mauritius' Special Economic Zones. Econometric estimations test the 'learning by importing', 'self-selection' and 'financial innovation' hypotheses, with the results suggesting that firms benefited from their experience in importing along with changes in financial availability. Thirdly, using an augmented gravity model, the export sophistication of both Mauritius and her trading partners are found to positively influence bilateral trade. Finally, applying Chenery decomposition techniques to Mauritian input-output data sheds light on intersectoral linkages and structural change.

The study contributes to knowledge primarily through its original empirical findings, which also have valuable policy implications.
