Mhaule, Victoria Nomthandazo (DCur)

Victoria obtained a BCur degree in 1991, National Higher Diploma in Nursing Education in 1993 from UNISA, MCur in Psychiatric Nursing from the University of Pretoria in 2006, and a Diploma in Occupational Nursing in 2013 from Occupational Care South Africa. She is currently working in the Department of Health of Mpumalanga.

Victoria observed that adolescents' involvement in aggression had been increasing in rural villages in Mpumalanga Province. Despite aggressions' everyday occurrence very little was known about the culture of aggression by adolescents in the rural community. The purpose of this study was to explore and describe the culture of aggression by adolescents in a rural community in Mpumalanga by utilising an ethnographic approach. Several patterns of aggression by adolescents were identified, namely patterns of anger, self-destructive behavior and disrespect. Based on the findings a conceptual framework was described to derive strategies to enable the management of adolescent aggression. These management strategies were implemented with parents, community leaders, teachers, adolescents and elders in a rural community in Mpumalanga. All the stakeholders involved experienced the implementation of the strategies as beneficial in the management of aggression by adolescents. The original contribution of this study is the conceptual framework and strategies to manage adolescent aggression.

Steyn, Erika (DCur)

Erika obtained a BCur degree from the former RAU, and during 1988 she obtained her Master's in Psychiatric Nursing (Child Psychiatric Nursing), also from the former Rand Afrikaans University. Erika is married and has four children, and is currently in private practice in Johannesburg.

The purpose of the thesis was to develop and evaluate a model as framework of reference for the advanced psychiatric nurse to facilitate the mental health of parents of premature babies in intensive care units (ICU). The experience of parents with premature babies in the ICU was explored and described through phenomenological individual interviews with them until data saturation was reached. The central concept of this study had been identified as the "*facilitating mindfulness*" of the parent. Facilitating parents' mindfulness help them to become conscious concerning their thoughts, feelings and experiences of hope. This in turn helps them to gain insight and assist them to become conscious concerning their choices in challenging situations and relationships. Their mental health is promoted through them becoming mindful. The original contribution of this study is the developed model to facilitate the mindfulness of parents.

Morris-Eyton, Heather Francis (DPhil)

Heather Morris-Eyton completed her undergraduate studies in Physical Education at the University of the Witwatersrand, followed by her Honours in Education and Masters in Adult Education from the same institution. She is the National Coach for Lifesaving South Africa and is involved in the preparation of the high performance lifesaving athletes at a national and provincial level.

Lifesaving sport as well as coach education programme implementation show a scarcity of comprehensive research globally and within the South African context. This is especially valid for sports federations and countries that are in the infancy of developing contextual models for coach education programmes for implementation. The coaches' perspectives on the value of an educational programme as well as their needs and requirements drove the development and implementation of a Lifesaving Coach Education programme. It also provided a system for coach development within a contextual coach education framework. This research gave a voice to the coaches regarding their own educational journey, and will assist curricular developers in gaining an insight into the needs of coaches, as well as critiquing the relevance of conventional and unconventional curricular content found in the development of coach education programmes. The practical application of coach education frameworks and curricular development may go a long way in assisting sports federations to establish clearly defined educational pathways that have sufficient flexibility for adapting to changes within a dynamic coaching environment. This is a hallmark study in the context of coach curriculum development in South Africa.
