## **Lambrechts, Hendrik Frederik Johannes (LLD)**

Mr Lambrechts obtained the degrees BA (Languages) (1990) and LLB (1994) from the former Rand Afrikaans University. After his admission as an attorney in 1996 he practised mainly in the Office of the State Attorney, Johannesburg. He also holds the degrees BTh (cum laude) (1998), for which he received the Faculty Medal; BTh (Hons) (cum laude) (2000); both from the University of South Africa, and an LLM degree in International Trade Law from the University of Stellenbosch (2003). He has been a director in the Tax Policy unit of the National Treasury, Republic of South Africa, since 2009.

In his thesis, Mr Lambrechts illustrates how a developing country can use controlled foreign company legislation to counter tax base erosion and profit shifting that are facilitated by globalisation and encouraged by harmful tax competition. He articulates the policy choices underlying the different aspects of this legislation. Mindful of the inherent tension between Capital Export Neutrality (facilitated by CFC rules) and Capital Import Neutrality (requiring the exemption of foreign business income), he focuses on how a developing country can coordinate its CFC legislation with the taxation of international business income so as not to deter foreign direct investment. Deriving lessons from South Africa's experience with anti-deferral rules, he develops a theoretical and conceptual framework for the implementation of CFC legislation in a developing economy. He supports his conclusions by drafting model provisions and an explanatory memorandum which could guide a developing country in its law reform process.

## **Venter, Roxan (LLD)**

Ms Venter is in 1986 in Roodepoort, Johannesburg gebore. Ná matrikulasie in 2004, het sy haar B.Com Regte (2007), LLB (2009), LLM-grade (2010) almal met lof aan die Universiteit van Johannesburg verwerf. Die Kanseliersmedalje vir die beste meestersverhandeling is in 2010 aan haar toegeken. Van 2011 tot die hede doseer sy staatsreg aan die Universiteit van Johannesburg. Sy het haar doktorsale proefskrif getiteld “Demokrasie en die Reg op Vryheid van Uitdrukking” in April 2016 voltooi. Sy publiseer op verskeie temas in staatsreg en het referate by verskeie internasionale konferensies gelewer.

Die belangrikheid van die begrippe “demokrasie” en “vryheid van uitdrukking” vir die kontemporêre staat behoef geen betoog nie. Ten spyte van algemene instemming, is albei begrippe in ’n onbestendige tydsgewrig egter broos genoeg om immergroen onderwerpe vir akademiese studie te bly. Die studie voer aan dat demokrasie en vryheid van uitdrukking dermate verweef is dat ’n demokrasie nie sonder vryheid van uitdrukking effektief kan funksioneer nie. Deur middel van diepgaande regshistoriese en regsvergelykende ontleding verhelder die studie die verband tussen die begrippe. Die insigte en voorstelle wat uit die ontleding spruit, het meer effektiewe erkenning en beskerming van vryheid van uitdrukking (en ander fundamentele regte), en verbeterde lewenskragtigheid en volhoubaarheid van die demokrasie ten doel. Die studie is ’n tydige en waardevolle bydrae wat beklemtoon dat elke samelewing verantwoordelik is om die interafhanklike verhouding tussen demokrasie en vryheid van uitdrukking te erken, koester en ontwikkel om stabiliteit binne state, sowel as binne die internasionale gemeenskap, te bevorder.
