Dafuleya, Gift (PhD)

Mr Gift Dafuleya obtained his Bachelor of Economics degree from the University of Zimbabwe in 2002 and went on to complete his Masters of Commerce at the National University of Science and Technology in 2007, where he also worked as a Lecturer of Economics in the Department of Banking. In 2008, he was appointed as an Economics Lecturer at the Ethiopian Civil Service University. Mr Dafuleya is currently employed as a Senior Lecturer in the Department of Economics at the University of Venda. His research interests are in social protection and development microeconomics. He is married to Sibonokuhle and has two children, Nomqhele and Melokuhle.

Mr Gift Dafuleya's thesis entitled, "Non-state social protection strategies of poor households in Bulawayo, Zimbabwe", breaks new ground in testing several hypotheses on the scope and effectiveness of non-state social protection, when most literature concentrates on state social provision. The thesis utilises household survey data collected by Mr Dafuleya in three communities in Bulawayo. Four risk mitigation strategies – migration, risk pooling through informal funeral insurance, mutual assistance and emergency relief extended to households in crisis – are assessed by means of economic modelling and econometric analysis. The thesis makes important theoretical, methodological and empirical contributions in the fields of development and household economics. The findings show that non-state social protection strategies in Zimbabwe are rescue driven, and lack complementary state social protection that could lift households out of poverty. The thesis underscores the importance of designing social policies that take greater account of the interaction between state and non-state forms of social protection.

Von Boetticher, Sven Thorsten (PhD)

Mr Sven Thorsten von Boetticher completed the degree BSc Financial Mathematics at the University of Johannesburg in 2012. He holds a BSc Honours in Financial Mathematics (cum laude) from the University of the Witwatersrand, which he completed in 2013. He registered for an MCom degree in Quantitative Finance at the University of Johannesburg in 2014. Due to his excellent research progress, he was the first student in the Faculty of Economic and Financial Sciences to have his registration upgraded to that of a PhD. Mr. von Boetticher received numerous awards as a student, which include the Top Achievers Award for BSc, and top student and best project in BSc Honours.

The candidate considered option pricing in the Piterbarg framework, which is an extension of the Black-Scholes-Merton option pricing model. The Piterbarg model uses a regime of interest rates whereas the Black-Scholes-Merton model uses only one interest rate. Mr von Boetticher considered various methods to calculate option prices using the Piterbarg model, which include the relative entropy principle, the Heston-Nandi model and GJR and EGARCH models. Mr von Boetticher's calculation of Dupire's formula and the Greeks in the Piterbarg model are imperative to the study of volatility and risk management. Mr von Boetticher's thesis also makes an important contribution to discrete hedging in the Piterbarg framework. He makes an original contribution to the area of option pricing by extending the Piterbarg methodology developed to interest rate derivatives, introducing credit risk into the Piterbarg model and considering hedging of credit risk in this model. Mr von Boetticher is the author or co-author of sixteen journal or conference proceedings research papers, most of which originated from his PhD thesis.
