### Study Abroad programmes



The first cohort of inbound Study Abroad students arrived at UJ in January. These students consist of bi-lateral exchange, ISEP (International Student Exchange Programme) and Erasmus Plus students.



Cornell University Law School, Institute of African Development and the Faculty of Law at UJ offer an annual Winter School programme. The programme took place from the 2nd to 21st January at UJ and 17 students from Cornell University participated in the programme.



## Delegation visits and events



A senior delegation from Shanghai Normal University, China visited UJ and met with the DVC: Research and Internationalisation and UJ colleagues. The aim of the meeting was to discuss potential areas of collaboration which included staff and student mobility, joint research programmes, developing a university consortium with 5-8 universities in global regions and interest in organizing teacher educational group visits to Shanghai China.
