Screening procedure and protocols

- 1. There will be two screening points at the campus control point
 - 1.1. One for vehicles and one for pedestrians
 - 1.2. See relevant map per campus
 - 1.3. Busses will off-load passengers on the outside of the campuses
- 2. This campus control point will serve staff, students and other stakeholders
- 3. The screening and access process is expected to take between 5 & 10 minutes. Persons must arrive early to ensure that they are not delayed.
- 4. Prerequisites for access to campus:
 - 4.1. All persons will be subjected to the screening process.
 - 4.1.1. Complete the screening process online using the mobile application (link to the application will be communicated in due course).
 - NB. Persons who do not have access to the application, will complete a manual screening register or online app at the gate. Additional time to be added onto the process.
 - 4.1.2. Over and above the screening process, temperature readings will be taken on arrival.
 - 4.1.3. Persons who do not pass the screening process will not be allowed onto campus.
 - 4.1.3.1. Such persons will be referred to the medical tent for further evaluation.
 - 4.1.3.2. Any persons who refuse to comply with the screening process will be denied access.
 - 4.2. All persons who pass the screening process will be issued with a clearance access sticker.
 - 4.3. All persons who successfully pass this process will then be subjected to the access control process before final access is granted to the campus. Refer to Procedure and Protocols for access.
