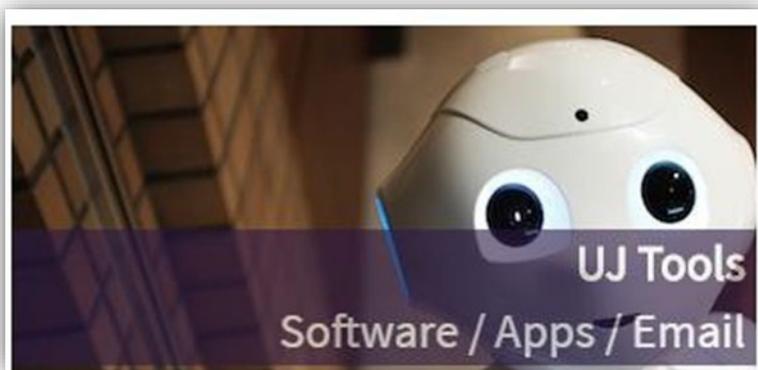
Subject: **Installation of Handbrake Stand-Alone**

This document is a user guide on the installation of handbrake video transcoder software from uLink. HandBrake is a free and open-source transcoder for digital video files, handbrake can be used to compress large video files so that they can be uploaded to Blackboard.

How to Access HandBrake

Step 1. Log into <https://ulink.uj.ac.za/>

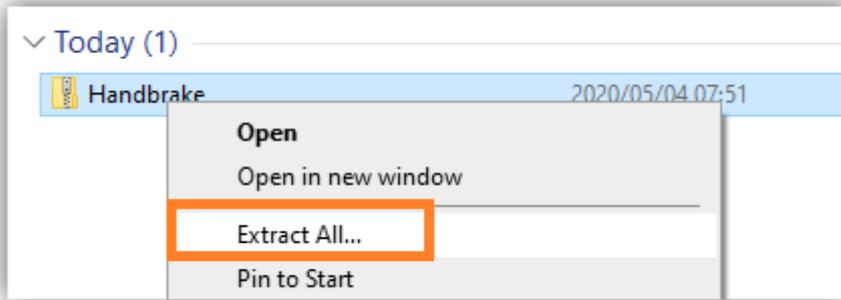
Step 2. Select and Open **UJ Tools**



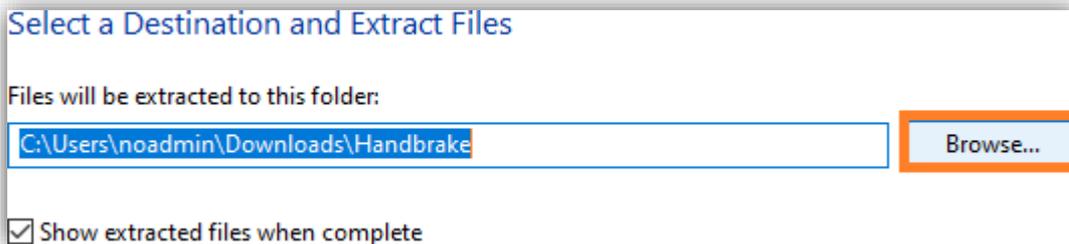
Step 3. Under “General Tools/Software” select and **download HandBrake**

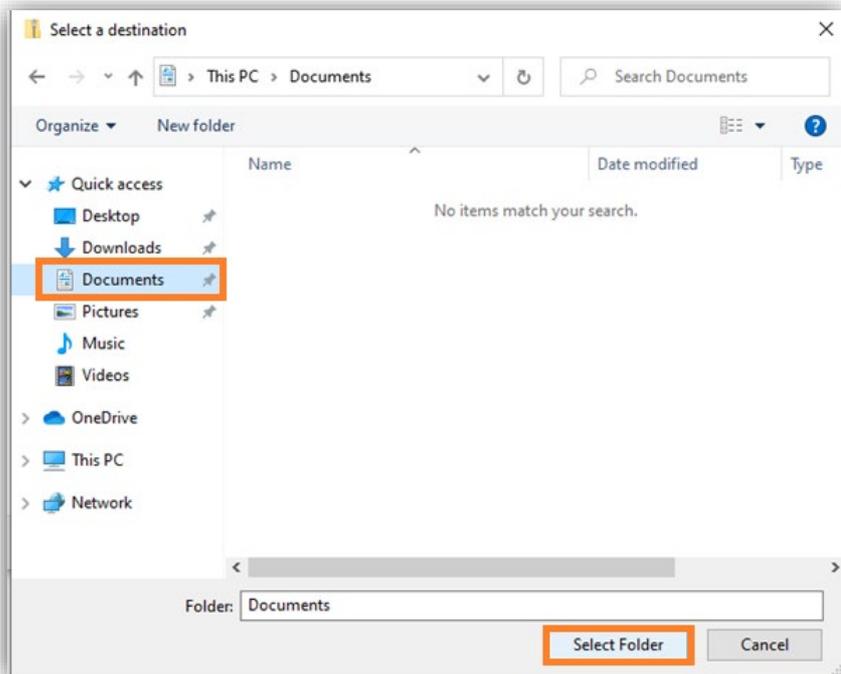
Step 4. Navigate to your downloads and Right click on the downloaded file and select **Extract All**



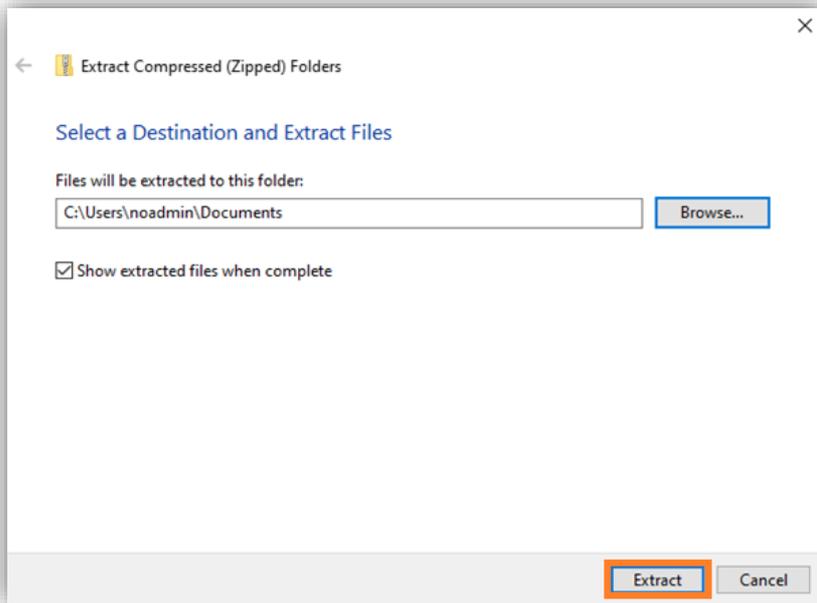
Step 5. Click on **Browse**



Step 6. On the left navigation pane click on **Documents** and click on **Select Folder**

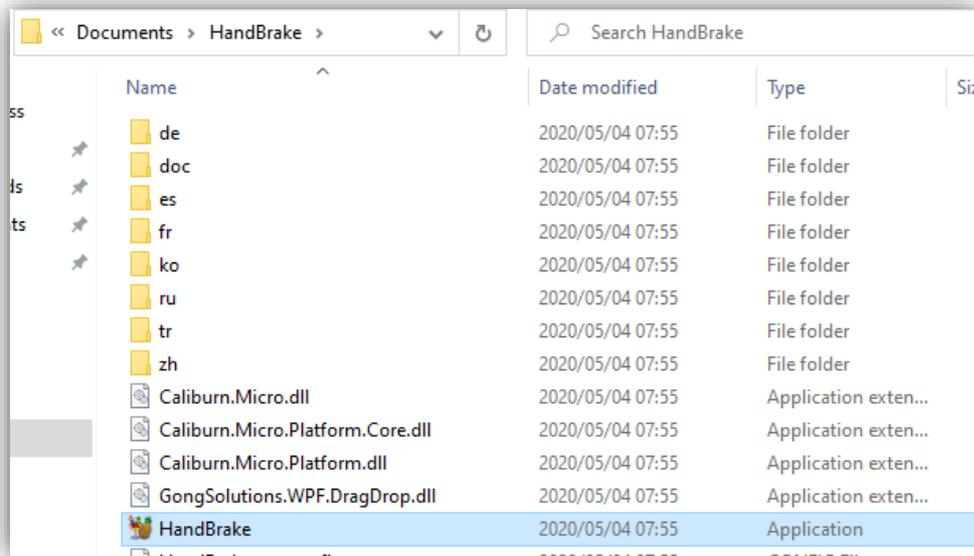


Step 7. Click on Extract



Step 8. Go to documents -> HandBrake and run HandBrake.
