Pre-assessment instructions were critical for preparation

- Detailed scope and instructions were sent before each assessment
- Examples of instructions regarding online format and technical requirements:
 - o Budget for 1GB of data
 - o Device fully charged
 - o Scanning app tested
 - o Latest dial-in time 15 mins before start
 - Inspection of physical space before start

- Examples of instructions for **physical set up**:
 - Prepare the space to be as comfortable as you can be
 - Enough space to write and have PC on desk
 - $\circ~$ Quiet room with a closed door
 - $\circ~$ No other people in the room
 - No clocks or any study material on the wall or placed around the room
