Admission requirements:

To gain admission into the BEd Honours in Education in Language Literacies and Literature a potential student should possess:

- A four-year Bachelor of Education degree with English/Linguistics (or related modules) as majors OR
- A general NQF level 7 first degree with English as major plus a 120c NQF level 7 Postgraduate Certificate in Education.

In addition to the minimum admission requirements as outlined above, prospective students who apply for this degree may undergo a selection process. The selection process may include personal interviews, panel interviews and written submissions and will take the following into account: previous academic achievement, personal skills, interpersonal skills, and the potential to develop the necessary critical academic reading and writing skills to become a good researcher of language, literacies and literature in education. The ability to engage critically with core issues is essential. An average of a minimum of 65% for the previous degree is required to be allowed into the programme.

Note that this is a contact programme. Prospective students are required to be able to attend all classes which are compulsory.

Classes are held on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons from 15.30 – 17.30. Students may select the part-time or full-time option.
