

## Compounding and Dispensing Course

## for Allied Health Professionals 2022

Subject to the provisions of section 22C of the Medicines and Related Substances Control Act, Act 101 of 1965 read together with Regulation 18 of the same Act, practitioners are required to apply for a Compounding and Dispensing License from the Director-General of the Department of Health.

The Department of Complementary Medicine at UJ is a registered provider of the South Africa Pharmacy Council (Certificate registration no. R10044) approved and accredited *Dispensing and Compounding Course for Allied Health Professionals*.

## The short learning program (SLP) is:

- A 6-month online learning program,
- Comprised of five theory modules, a general dispensing component, and one discipline-specific module and practical for compounding for i) Homeopaths or ii) Chinese Medicine & Acupuncture.

## Successful completion of the course will require an overall pass mark of 60% comprised of:

- Online module assessments,
- An exit portfolio,
- A final online assessment, and
- An on-campus compounding and dispensing practicum in March 2023.

Application and registration for the SLP opens on 1 September 2022.

The course commences online on 3 October 2022.

A maximum of 30 candidates can be accommodated per SLP intake.
