ELIGIBILITY

- Be a South African Citizen or permanent resident;
- Be an NRF-funded doctoral student or postdoctoral fellow for the full duration of the Mitacs award;
- Participants cannot undertake a research project at an institution where they have previously completed a degree;
- Be the legal age of majority in Canada (18 years or older);
- Have not previously been awarded a Globalink Research Award; and
- Have identified a research project that is endorsed by the Canadian host university and will be jointly supervised by both the applicant's host Canadian and home university professors.

APPLICATION MODALITIES

- **1.** South African or Canadian host supervisors are asked to fill out a webform on the Mitacs website to request an application package. Note: If you are a student or fellow at an eligible institution, please contact your supervising professor to request an application package. The supervisors must confirm eligibility with the Mitacs local representative before starting to fill in the application documents.
- 2. The South African and Canadian host supervisors discuss project details. It is the responsibility of the participants to connect with prospective Canadian collaborative partners. Limited support in linking up with a potential Canadian host can be provided by Mitacs. Do contact the NRF contacts for more information.
- 3. Complete the application package online on the Mitacs website and submit it to the Mitacs Business Development representative at the Canadian university early November to ensure the application is signed by the deadline.
