Prof Boitumelo Molebogeng Diale is the outgoing President of the Convocation at the University of Johannesburg, where she has been in office from September 2019 to September 2022. As an academic, Prof Diale is an Associate Professor and Vice Dean of Teaching and Learning in the Faculty of Education at the UJ. From 2017 to June 2021, Prof Diale was the Head of the Department of Educational Psychology. Prof Diale is a registered Educational Psychologist with the Health Professions Council of South Africa and an Employee Wellness Practitioner. At a global level, until September 2021 Diale was the Chairperson of the South African Career Development Association (SACDA) Prof Diale was elected in 2022 for the second year as the chairperson of the South African College of Applied Psychology (SACAP) Academic Board. Prof Diale is also a Visiting Professor at the University of Nigeria, Nsukka (UNN) since 2019.

Prof Diale plays an advisory role and is active at the UJ Transformation Unit where she presents on various transformation platforms and conversations. She also is an invited guest and gives expert advice related to education and psychology on various media platforms such as the SABC, ETV news, Newzroom and other radio stations.

As a women leader, Prof Diale is currently mentoring six young female academics from the faculties of Education, Humanities and CBE as part of the Academic Accelerated Mentoring Programme (AAMP) and the UJ Women Leadership Programme. She also mentors many other young female students and academics from the UJ and other institutions. At a community level, Prof Diale was one of the three finalists for the Fabulous Women of the Year Awards and is the recipient of the Duduza Heroes Best Leadership Award.
