The qualification is targeted to new graduates in HR, seasoned and new HR professionals and those that are eager to equip themselves in effective people management practices.

WHAT ARE THE QUALIFICATION OBJECTIVES?

The Advanced Diploma in People Performance Management offers a focused and applied specialisation in performance analytics, total remuneration and people management modules appropriate to the needs of South Africa and other emerging economies. The programme prepares students to operate at a specialist transactional level utilising tactical strategy in operational settings.

Students would be enabled to interpret implications of HR decisions on organisational and employee performance and provide suggestions, recommendations and managerial implications on such matters. The programme furthermore prepares students for postgraduate study in human resource management at either Postgraduate Diploma or Honours degree level.

The exit level outcomes of the qualification are aligned with the requirements of the NQF level 7 and students are required to apply theoretical and practical knowledge to solve strategic case studies, creating solutions for complex business and people-related problems through a rigorous and innovative academic discourse.

This qualification is presented on the Bunting Road Campus. This is a fulltime/part time qualification. Classes are presented on a daily basis. Class attendance is compulsory.
