



NRF GENERAL SCHOLARSHIPS FOR HONOURS STUDENTS IN 2023

Are you interested in doing an Honours in Economics at UJ in 2023?

The DSI/NRF South African Research Chair in Industrial Development is calling for Honours students in economics who will be full time registered at UJ in 2023. The Chair will provide application motivation support to high-achieving and motivated students. The NRF honours full bursaries cover fees. Bursary holders will join a prestigious and dynamic research community at SARChI Industrial Development, led by Prof Fiona Tregenna.

Eligibility:

- The NRF minimum academic requirement for postgraduate funding is 65%.
- The entry age requirement is 28, 30 and 32 years or younger.
- Must be full-time honours students (students cannot be in full-time employment) in 2023.
- Must be registered in any of the honours programmes offered in the School of Economics at UJ in 2023.
- The honours research project must be supervised or co-supervised by Prof Fiona Tregenna and/or other members of the SARChI Industrial Development team, and must be linked to the broad field of industrial development.

About the South African Research Chair in Industrial Development:

The South African Research Chairs Initiative (SARChI) is funded by the Department of Science and Innovation and administered by the National Research Foundation. The Chair is hosted at UJ, where it operates as a centre in the College of Business and Economics. We host Postdoctoral Research Fellows as well as doctoral, masters and honours students and research assistants, and affiliated international research associates.
