PREAMBLE

The University of Johannesburg's Applied Information Systems Department introduces the 'End User Computing' Short Learning Programme (SLP), designed for individuals who seek to develop foundational computing skills. This course introduces learners to basic IT concepts, common functions of a personal computer (PC), and an overview of essential software applications.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this SLP is to introduce learners to key computing concepts, including basic IT terminology, computer components, and operating systems. The course also covers essential Microsoft Office applications, such as Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and Access, enabling learners to apply these tools to solve business-related problems.

Students will be able to manipulate files and use software for word processing, presentations, spreadsheets and database applications to solve business problems. Students will be able to search the internet and utilise e-mail.

Grade 12 (Matric certificate)

This SLP is offered face-to-face over a semester. This programme is structured around 12 sessions of 8 hours each. Applications are accepted throughout the year.

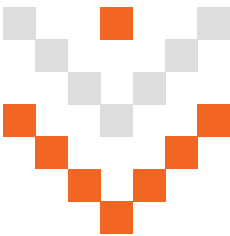
