TSCM assisted its prospective limited contact CEP students with applications and registrations in January and February 2022. TSCM registered a total of **3 305** students for the 2022 intake.



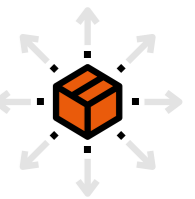
Farewell Party Honouring Dr Carstens
