APPLICATIONS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS CLOSES 30 AUGUST

If you are a foreigner (non-South African citizen), please make sure to contact the International Office for the application process as well as the legislation requirements – international@uj.ac.za. Or you may visit the Homepage for the necessary information: www.uj.ac.za/international Foreign qualifications for postgraduate studies must be evaluated by the South African Qualification Authority (SAQA). Details are available on the International Office Homepage, how to apply for Academic Programmes.

Please Note:

The International Office recently came across legislation that foreign persons on a work permit may not study at all. This has been confirmed by the Department of Home Affairs. This is also relevant to part-time studies. However, such persons are permitted to go to UNISA to study by means of distance learning as Unisa is considered to be a non-residential institution.

However, this legislation might change in the near future. It is unclear when this might happen but currently the Department of Home Affairs of South Africa insists that no foreigners may study while on a work permit.
