

## Postdoctoral Research Fellowship (PDRF)

## **APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF FUNDING 2024**

Upon approval of the appointment of PDRF at UJ, the Host has the responsibility of requesting a source of funding from the Faculty-URC funds or UJ-GES, provided that the PDRF is within the three years of fellowship.

## **INTERNAL FUNDING**

- 1. The total monetary value of the Faculty-URC fellowship is R250 0000 per annum (R125 000 from URC and R125 000 from the faculty) during the tenure of the fellowship.
- 2. The total monetary value of the UJ Global Excellence and Stature (UJ-GES) Fellowship is R250 000 per annum.
