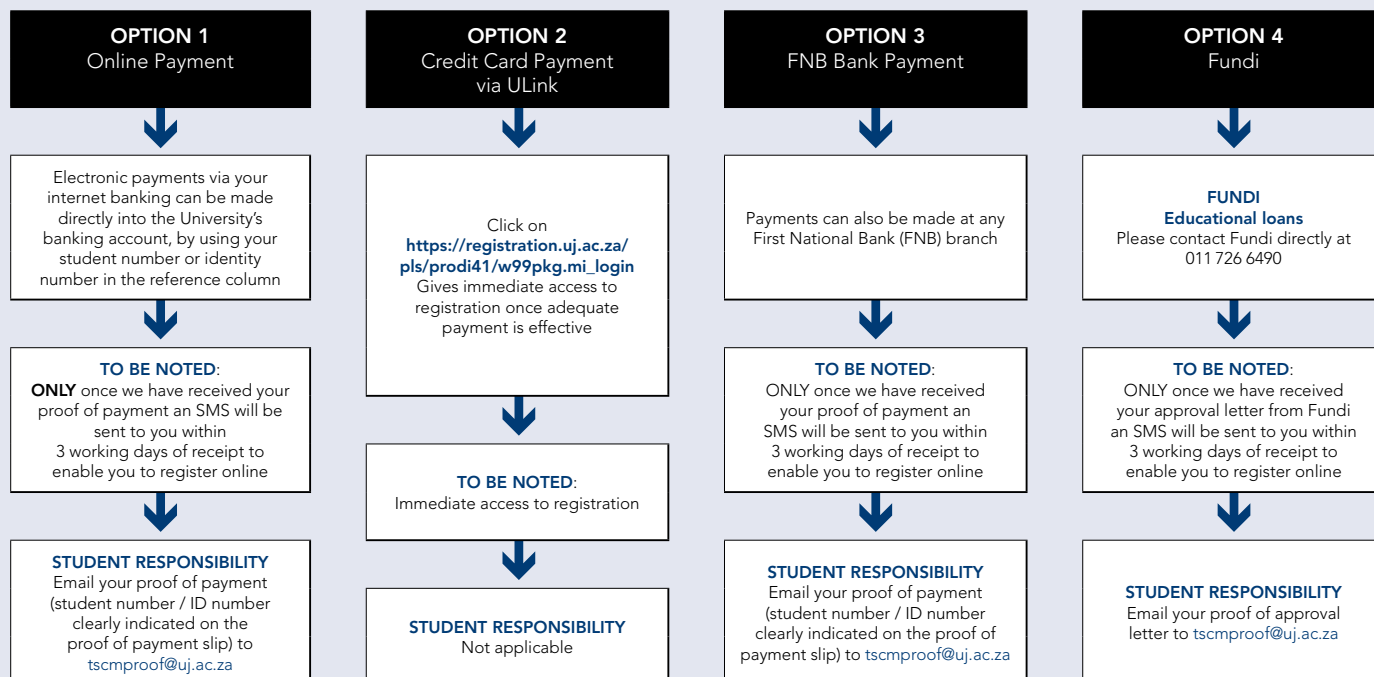

Third payment	(latest by 15 August 2022) / Outstanding balance (40% of fees for the year)
