


Graduation Programme

Daniel Kamotho holds a Bachelor of Commerce Honours (Accounting) from the University of Nairobi in Kenya, a Master's degree in Business Administration from ESAMI in Tanzania, and a Postgraduate Certificate in Higher Education from the Namibia University of Science and Technology (NUST).

He is a Certified Public Accountant of Kenya (CPA), an associate member of the South African Institute of Chartered Accountants (SAICA) and the South African Institute of Business Accountants (SAIBA). He lectures accounting at the Namibia University of Science and Technology (NUST). He has gained work experience from Shell, TNT International, Kenya Pipeline Company, Ernst & Young and Price Waterhouse.

The study sought to examine the decision-useful of integrated reports for Namibian listed companies. The qualitative CA assessed the usefulness of information in the IR. The survey determined the information needs of users and interviews with preparers aimed at gaining insights into the process of preparing IRs. Results indicate that IRs prepared are limited due to the narrative nature of disclosures that not substantive. A self-assessment framework was proposed to address this GAP.

Carol Beverley Thompson holds a BCom (Marketing), BCom Honours (Investment Management) and MCom (Investment Management) degree from the former RAU and UJ. She started her career as a Risk Analyst Statistician at Alexander Forbes and moved on to work in various industries such as financial, insurance, consulting, automotive, and telecoms.

She is currently employed as Senior Analyst Advanced Analytics. Highlights of her career include receiving awards for performance excellence for her work done in building fees calculators and decision trees used during the Competition Commission banking fees inquiry; building complex models (inventory invoicing, financial disclosure note, and data models); and creativity in creating end to end analytical solutions and mentoring graduates.

Abnormal cash holdings levels are recorded globally. This study investigated the cash holdings behaviour on an aggregated and disaggregated level for JSE listed firms. The findings show that cash holdings levels changed due to transaction, precautionary and speculative motives. This study contributed theoretically by introducing the use of the accounting cash ratio to identify abnormal cash holdings. In addition, it contributed by including both Financial and Non-Financial firms to identify determinants of cash holdings.
