Adeola Oluwatoyin Osundiran currently working in the field of Maritime Supply Chain Management; Port Efficiency and Data Envelopment Analysis.

International trade is a driving force for global economic growth. The candidate developed hybrids of Data Envelope Analysis models for performance evaluation of sub-Saharan African container ports over a period from 2008-2015. Advanced statistical models were generated for the determination of productivity, and quantification of indices of efficiency and inefficiency of container ports. A general framework for efficient operation of sub-Saharan Africa container ports was developed. The findings were published in ports and maritime logistics journals.
