Heine, Lee (DTech)

Lee Heine was awarded her master's degree (*cum laude*) in 2007 and completed her doctorate at the University of Johannesburg in 2021. She is an HPCSA medical technologist board-registered microbiologist with experience at both private and public pathology laboratories. She specialises in medical microbiology and have taught this, along with several biomedical sciences related subjects, at two South African universities. While completing her doctorate, she worked as a research assistant for the Water and Health Research Centre and as a part-time lecturer at the University of Johannesburg. She also acted as cosupervisor for a master's study in biomedical science.

In low-income countries, diarrhoea is a significant cause of morbidity and mortality worldwide with most deaths occurring in children under the age of five years. The aim of the study was to investigate the prevalence of enteric pathogens in stools of children under the age of five years presenting with diarrhoea at clinics and hospitals in the Limpopo province, and to evaluate the antimicrobial susceptibility of the pathogenic bacteria. Using the BioFire[®] Film Array[®] GI Panel to determine the prevalence of diarrhoea-causing enteric pathogens, 82.2% of the samples tested positive for at least one pathogen and 57.3% tested positive for between two and seven different pathogens. The antimicrobial susceptibility of bacterial pathogens showed most were multidrug resistant with only thirteen isolates classified as extensively drug resistant. The study highlighted the need to better understand the co-occurrence and potential co-infection of pathogenic microorganisms, and the bacterial antibiotic resistance in this area.
