# Holtzhausen, Jan Dirk Visagie (DNSc)

JD Holtzhausen graduated from North-West University (Potchefstroom) in the Bachelor of Nursing programme in 2015. His master's dissertation, 'The influence of the practice environment on community service nurses' subjective wellbeing and compassion fatigue' was supervised by Prof SK Coetzee and completed in 2017. JD worked his community service year in Grootvlei Community Health Clinic. Thereafter, he started his employment with Life Suikerbosrand Hospital in Heidelberg. At the end of 2018, JD and Rinemaré moved to Auckland, NZ, where JD was employed at Auckland City Hospital. Currently, JD and his wife reside in Timaru, NZ, where JD works at a local hospital.

There is currently no professional registration available in South Africa for nurse anaesthetists by which they prescribe and administer anaesthesia and chemical pain management services to patients.

This study was conducted in four steps: In Step One, concept analysis took place. In Step Two, the relational statements of these described concepts were formulated. In Step Three, the model was further described, developed and evaluated by model-specific experts. In Step Four, the guidelines for the implementation of the model were generated from the process description of the model. Thereafter, the practice model and guidelines were evaluated by anaesthetist experts.

This research study was important. First, it is a landmark research study in the development of a practice model for nurse anaesthesia in South Africa. Secondly, it provided an overview of current nurse anaesthetist practices from across the world. Thirdly, this research study defined the scope of practice of a nurse anaesthetist in South Africa.
