

# Short Learning Programme 2: Implementation of the Green Transport Strategy

#### WHY GREEN TRANSPORT?

The Green Transport Strategy (2018-2050) launched by the Department of Transport is intended to:

- Reduce greenhouse gas emissions and other negative environmental impacts of the transport sector
- Promote economic growth and boost jobs

The Implementation of the Green Transport Strategy SLP builds on the Introduction to Green Transport SLP and conveys the tools and skills needed for developing and implementing sustainable transport initiatives.

### THE PROGRAMME

The Short Learning Programme (SLP) is a hybrid of online (on UJ's Blackboard platform) and contact learning:

- Online self-study is in participant's own time (16 hours plus 20 hours for assessments)
- Classroom learning is for lectures and group exercises (5 days)
