

UJELP Invitation and information letter (2024)

Dear International prospective student

We are delighted that you have chosen to further your studies at the University of Johannesburg (UJ).

Please note that all prospective undergraduate or postgraduate international students who have not studied in English are required by UJ to provide English Proficiency Test results.

For those candidates who may not have the certificate attesting their English proficiency, the University of Johannesburg English Language Programme (UJELP) provides such a proficiency test and offers English as a Foreign Language (EFL) course divided into three modules: Elementary (A1-A2), Intermediate (B1-B2) and Advanced (C1-C2).

The proficiency test administered by UJELP is referred to as Placement Test (PT). It is divided into PT1 and PT2. The Placement Test determines the candidate's English proficiency. It is a gateway through which successful candidates may enter the faculty of their choice, provided they satisfy UJ's admission requirements. Furthermore, UJELP accommodates candidates who do not have the required English proficiency into the UJELP course at the end of which a certificate of proficiency will be delivered by the University of Johannesburg.

UJELP Placement Test application processes

Before applying for PT, please generate/apply for a student number first.

Step 1: Apply for a student number.

- 1.1 To obtain a UJ student number/reference, please use this easy-to-follow UJ application site: https://registration.uj.ac.za/pls/prodi41/wuj012pkg.wuj012 startup
 - Please select the appropriate academic year of study
 - ❖ Type "PLTEST" in the <u>token</u> space provided and click the search icon/button below. Then click the search icon/button. Please click on the UJELP icon, then fill in the form until the end. Please click on "I accept" at the end /bottom of the form.
 - Then click on "proceed with application". An email will be sent to you with your UJ student number once the process is completed.

Step 2: Placement Tests- Phase 1 and 2 bookings

Phase 1 Placement Test (PT1) is to be completed only in the student's respective country of origin/outside of South Africa.

Please make sure that you have the following:

- a. CERTIFIED Passport
- b. CERTIFIED and TRANSLATED matriculation/grade 12/high school transcript (results)
- c. Proof of payment for the Placement test (per cost section below)
- d. A valid Gmail email address

e. Nine (9) digit UJ student number (to be used as a reference in all communications)

Placement Test cost: A non-refundable Placement Test cost in Rand, is (ZAR) 1500 (one thousand five hundred rands only). This payment is inclusive of PT1 and PT2 provided that PT2 is written within 6 months. The PT1 results and payment thereof will not be valid after the indicated period of 6 months. Failure to complete PT2 within 6 months, the candidate will need to start the process afresh. Please note that prices are subject to change.

- i. A valid Gmail email address
- j. Nine (9) digit UJ student number (to be used as a reference in all communications)
