**Azionya, Caroline Mulaluka DLitt et Phil** (Marketing Communication)

Caroline Azionya is an experienced marketing communications professional and chartered public relations practitioner in the fast-moving consumer goods (FMCG) financial services and telecommunications industry in South Africa and Lesotho. She obtained an MA Marketing Communication degree (*cum laude*) from UJ, where she lectures strategic communication. She has developed modules, taught and supervised up to postgraduate level and has published and presented nationally and internationally. Caroline's pioneering teaching methods have led to collaborations with industry, the UN, AU and non-governmental organisations (NGOs) resulting in over 14 student awards and recognition from the European Commission. Her research interests include generation and brand theory, value creation in 4IR and digital multi-sided platforms.

This study aimed to assess who South African millennials are, how they interact on digital multi-sided platforms, the value they create on such platforms, and who benefits from that value. Using value theory, symbolic interactionism and generational cohort theory as theoretical frameworks, a multi-paradigmatic, transdisciplinary approach was adopted to research the complexity of value creation in the context of the Fourth Industrial Revolution. A conceptual model of value creation and a measuring instrument were developed that explain, amongst others, a critical shift from consumers to prosumers. The benefits that platform owners derive from a shift in relationship between brands and prosumers were also highlighted. These findings

strongly resonate with the most recent predictions of famous seminal author Jürgen Habermas. External assessors describe the study as unique in its angle and highly publishable as it makes a substantial academic contribution in an exponentially exploding field where the practice of value is ahead of academic discourse.

## **Mushonga, Simbai PhD (Social Work)**

Born and raised in Zimbabwe, Simbai Mushonga trained as a primary school teacher at Mkoba Teachers college in 1994; completed a professional course in Systemic Counselling with the Zimbabwe Institute of Systemic Counselling in 2004; completed her Bachelor of Social Work degree in 2009 and her master's degree in Social Work in 2011, both at the National University of Lesotho (NUL). Simbai taught social work at the NUL from 2011 to 2021. In addition to her research on interactional resilience, Simbai has also conducted and published research on young people's transition out of the care system.

The candidate has pioneered the field of interactional resilience. Resilience refers to the social processes that people engage in to enable them to overcome adversity in life. Much resilience research focuses on psychological processes, such as optimism and grit. Other research, particularly in social work, has focused on the contribution of the social environment to the resilience of individuals. The candidate has opened up a new path in resilience theory, by focusing on the interaction between people and their environment, rather than on just the person or their environment. This is a quintessential social work study, that is concerned with the liminal spaces between systems. Her in-depth qualitative study involved 15 National University of Lesotho students, raised by alcohol-misusing caregivers. Each participant was interviewed on three occasions, using both traditional interviews and draw-and-write creative methods. Her research uncovered innovative interactions that young people engage in to enable them to avoid substance misuse, to do well academically and to feel fulfilled in life.
