Phumuza Langa is currently a senior manager commercial analyst in the University of Johannesburg Technology Transfer Office. He has over a decade experience in research and development (R&D) commercialisation. In the past has been employed as the R&D Outcomes Manager at the Council for Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR), responsible for technology commercialisation matters and as a manager at the University of Pretoria where he was responsible for several commercialisation aspects, such as licensing and business plan development. His academic research interests are within the field of strategic management of technology and innovation, with a focus on intellectual property commercialisation.

The candidate completed his doctoral studies on operational services of technology stations and incubators affecting the development of dynamic capabilities for innovative smallmedium enterprises (SMES). The main aim of the study was to develop a framework that would be utilised to determine the operational services of technology business incubators affecting development of dynamic capabilities for innovative the enterprises (SMEs). This was achieved through a framework developed and termed the Incubation Services Capabilities Quadrant. Some of the themes that emerged strongly relate to adaptability, strategic change, innovation, and repurposing when organisational agility is the identified dynamic capability. This study sheds some light on what services the business incubators should focus on and what dynamic capabilities will potentially be of importance. This will contribute largely to the

field of Operations Management as it talks directly to SME and incubation productivity.

Mabinane, Letjedi Thabang PhD (Operations Management)

Mabinane Thabang completed his PhD in Operations Management at the University of Johannesburg in October 2022. Mr Mabinane is a Research Analyst at Transnet SOC. His responsibilities include compiling guarterly economic reports on and producing various reports South Africa across kev commodity segments. He also compiles briefing packs for the Group CEO and the Chief Business Development Officer. He equally compiles monthly market intelligence reports that go to the Minister of Public Enterprises, Mr Pravin Gordhan, through Transnet Chairperson, Dr Popo Molefe. Mr Mabinane is also a responsible for Research, Policy Development, Director Monitoring and Evaluation at the South African BRICS Youth Association.

The candidate's research seeks to introduce a country-specific yet integrated methodological framework for assessing a country's web index, using South Africa as a pilot country. In this research, the methodological framework was successfully introduced, guided by a conceptual framework that rested on nine key online tabs/features. The study followed a positivism research philosophy and adopted a quantitative, deductive-inductive-based analytical approach. The new framework was able to compute South Africa's web index at 0.2066/1.00 points. Therefore, the new framework was deemed feasible.

He also completed his BCom Honours in Industrial Psychology at the University of Johannesburg (UJ) in 2006 and a BTech in Business Administration 1999 UNISA. His undergraduate in at qualification is a National Diploma in Organization and Work Study, which completed in 1995 was at Technikon Witwatersrand. He spent 10 years in the mining industry and 10 years as a lecturer at UJ.
