SACAIR is affiliated with the Centre for Al Research (CAIR). CAIR is a South African distributed research network established in 2011 to build world-class Artificial Intelligence research capacity in South Africa. CAIR conducts foundational, directed and applied research into various aspects of Al through several research groups: Adaptive and Cognitive Systems, Al and Cybersecurity, Al for Development, Foundations and Applications of Machine Learning, Computational Logic, Ethical and Legal aspects of Al, Computational Intelligence, Knowledge Representation and Reasoning, and Probabilistic Modelling. An essential part of CAIR's mandate is to develop and nurture an Artificial Intelligence ecosystem within South Africa.

SACAIR 2023 is the fourth to be held under the SACAIR brand. The conference will build on the successes of the past three conferences.

SACAIR 2023 will be hosted at 26 Degrees South in Mulderdrift, Gauteng from 4 to 8 December 2023.


SACAIR 2023 will offer five main tracks:
