- Sustainable Mobility and Transportation: Innovations in eco-friendly transportation options, such as electric vehicles, bike-sharing programs, and efficient public transit systems, promoting green and equitable mobility.

2. Digital Transformation – examples:

- Digital Healthcare Technologies: Innovations in telemedicine, health monitoring apps, electronic health records, and diagnostic tools to improve healthcare accessibility and delivery.
- E-Government Solutions: Digital innovations that enhance government services, engage citizens, and promote transparency in governance.
- Fintech and Financial Inclusion: Applications of digital technology in the financial sector, including mobile banking, peer-to-peer lending platforms, and blockchain-based solutions that expand access to financial services.

3. Inclusive Innovation – examples:

- Accessible Technology for All: Innovations focused on making technology and digital services accessible to people with disabilities, including assistive devices, screen readers, and inclusive design principles.
