Bio: Daniel Capps is an associate professor in Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies Education at the University of Georgia in the United States. His research focuses on understanding how to design learning experiences that will support teachers and students in learning about what science is and the different ways it is practiced. Daniel's research has been regularly supported by the National Science Foundation. In his most recent project, Deep Structure Modelling (https://modelingbigideas.org/), he and his colleagues address the pressing need to organise science teaching and learning around "big ideas" that run more effectively through disciplines.
