


Title: *In Love & Intimate* / Jerry Mofokeng-wa Makhetha





Description of the book

'Why bother to rob a bank, when you can own a bank?' asked Bertold Brecht. The question is reiterated in the very Brechtian *Love, Crime and Johannesburg*, the story of Jimmy 'Long Legs' Mangane, a people's poet involved in the struggle, who is accused of robbing a bank. He passionately asserts his innocence, claiming to work for the 'secret service'. Lewis, his old friend and comrade from the struggle, now owns a bank. How did this happen? The man of the struggle is now a man of accounts. A man of the nineties. Part of the cell phone generation. Added to the mix is an old-style gangster, two girlfriends, a Jewish father and a very unusual Chief of Police. Described as one of the first genuine post-apartheid plays, *Love, Crime and Johannesburg* is a witty, light-hearted account of life in the City of Gold at the turn of the millennium. A must for all students of South African theatre. Winner of the 2000 Vita Award for best script of a new South African Play.




Title: *Fig jam and foxtrot: Tales of life, love and food in the Karoo / Lynn Bedford Hall; illustrated by Tony Grogan*

Although the women, like their little town of Corriebush, are fictitious, author Lynn Bedford Hall has attributed the recipes to them. Because they are so different in character, each woman brings a new approach to her menu - the recipes are diverse, exciting and tailored to suit today's tastes. This is a book that can be enjoyed while relaxing, feet up, and reading about Rosa, the town's Italian beauty, or it can be shared with family and friends after preparing Rosa's Fast Fusilli with Rocket. Or read about Olympia from Greece and her tragic tale, and then savour her Pilaff with Mushrooms and Prawns. There are six women, six absorbing tales and over 80 delectable dishes. And with Lynn's tried-and-tested recipes, you cannot possibly go wrong.
