He was awarded a Honoris Causa Doctor recognition by Universidad Tecnológica - ECOTEC, Ecuador (one of the world's most renowned Universities in sustainability related domains, recognized by its unique scientific and technological model), for his relevant contribution to the fields of education and sustainability.

Since he graduated he has published several peer reviewed papers at the national and international levels and he has been a guest researcher and lecturer both at Michigan State University (USA), and at the University of Toronto (Canada) where he has developed part of his Ph.D. research with the financial support from the Portuguese Foundation for Science and Technology (Ph.D. grant).
