BIOGRAPHY

Prof. J.C. van der Walt was born in Theunissen in the Free State. He started his school career at the farm school Eensgevonden. The family moved to Bloemfontein and he completed his schooling at Grey College.

He obtained his B.A. (Law) and LL.B. at UOVS and studied for two years as a DAAD student in Hamburg, Germany.

In 1979 he published an authoritative law book, *Die onregmatige daad (Delict)*. He spent his entire professional career at RAU, where he was promoted, consecutively, to Professor in the Law Faculty, Dean of the Law Faculty, Vice-Rector and, in July 1995, Rector. After 34 years of service at the RAU, Prof. Van der Walt retired, in February 2001, as 4th Rector and Vice-Chancellor of the Rand Afrikaans University.
