On 28 March 2025, the Southern Africa Towards Inclusive Economic Development (SA-TIED) programme, a flagship initiative of the United Nations University World Institute for Development Economics Research (UNU-WIDER), in partnership with the DSI/NRF South African Research Chair in Industrial Development (SARChI-ID) in the College of Business and Economics at the University of Johannesburg.
